Primary Responsibilities

Community Representation

- Serve as a positive and professional representative of WISM in public settings.
- Build relationships with elected officials, community leaders, nonprofit organizations, educators, and civic stakeholders.

Information Gathering & Reporting

- Take detailed notes during meetings and community events.
- Track discussions, decisions, initiatives, and emerging community concerns that may impact WISM or the communities we serve.

- Prepare concise reports and summaries for Pastor Mack, Executive Pastor Freida, and church leadership.
- Highlight opportunities for engagement, partnerships, outreach, advocacy, and ministry involvement.

Strategic Community Engagement

- Proactively identify upcoming meetings, public forums, and community events that align with WISM's mission and values.
- Maintain a calendar of civic and community engagement opportunities.
- Alert church leadership to important issues, developments, and opportunities requiring awareness or action.
- Recommend ways WISM can strengthen its community presence and increase its impact.

Community Partnership Development

- Help identify opportunities for collaboration with local organizations, schools, government agencies, and community groups.
- Connect church leadership with key stakeholders when appropriate.
- Assist in creating pathways for WISM members to engage in meaningful community service and civic involvement.

- Excellent note-taking, organizational, and reporting abilities.
